**CARE MANAGEMENT** is a collaborative, person-centered service that focuses on the coordination and management of someone's care and support needs, using a holistic approach.

## COMPONENTS OF CARE MANAGEMENT



### **ASSESSMENT**

Identify the individual's baseline status, support needs, current supports, available resources, goals, and potential barriers to accessing support.



### M CARE PLANNING

Create a written care plan that identifies short-term an long-term support needs, goals, and stakeholders. The care plan outlines an action plan for coordination and monitoring and is updated as needs change.



# COORDINATION

- Identify and coordinate services/transportation
- Make referrals, schedules services, attend meetings/appointments
- Keep stakeholders informed to assist with decision making.

The Care Manager monitors the safety and well-being of the individual, quality of care from support services, monitors for changes to the individual's baseline status, and ensures support needs are met.
